



Allen D. Walters

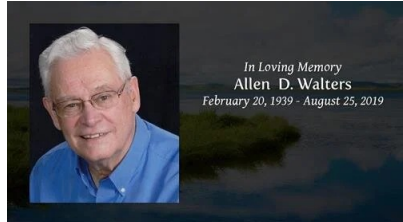
February 20, 1939 - August 25, 2019
