Al was a graduate of Creston High School; Hope College, and the University of Michigan, where he earned a master's degree in Science and a Ph.D. Al worked at Upjohn Company and Dow Chemical before beginning his teaching career. He taught high school in Ann Arbor, and taught at the University of Maryland, Western Michigan University, and the University of Cincinnati before his retirement at which time he moved to Holland.

Al was a veteran of World War II, having worked on the Manhattan project at the University of Chicago and serving at the Air Force Base in Salt Lake City, Utah.
