Angie Vanden Heuvel of Zeeland went to be with her Lord and Savior on November 5, 2025. She was born October 9, 1925, to the late Jacob and Winnie Geerts. She was a lifelong member of First Christian Reformed Church and served as church secretary several years. Angie taught Sunday School, was Bible leader for Christian Fellowship, Priscilla Mission Society, Coffee Break Bible Study, and worked with Helping Hands Sewing Group.

She graduated from Zeeland Christian School and Zeeland High School and was secretary at Colonial Manufacturing Company. Dennis Vanden Heuvel and Angie were lifelong friends. After World War II, Dennis was discharged from the United States Army Air Force, and they were married in First CRC where both have been members all their lives. The Lord gave them 76 years together. After Dennis retired, they volunteered with World Renew. Dennis passed away in August of 2022.

Angie is survived by her children Rev. Jack and Karen Vanden Heuvel of Victoria, MN, Dawn and Douglas Terpstra of Orland Park, IL, Nancy and Rev.
