



Pastor Audley Earl Boeve

May 30, 1930 - March 28, 2024

Pastor Audley Earl Boeve, 93, of Holland, passed away peacefully, surrounded by his family, on Thursday, March 28, 2024, at his home.

Audley was born May 30, 1930, on the Boeve Family Farm in East Holland, Michigan, to Edward and Jennie (Lubbers) Boeve. He worked in farming and plumbing early in life, but his true call was to the ministry. After ministerial training he worked as a pastor throughout the entirety of his life. He was a member of Lifegate Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 71 years, Lillian June (Walters) Boeve, in 2021, and also his great-grandson, Joel Boeve, in 2020, and his sister Joyce Kuiper.

He is survived by his children: Marge (Jim) Schuitema, Dave (Deb) Boeve, Jack (Lisa) Boeve, Cindy (Steve) Nyhof; 10 grandchildren, 16 great-grandchildren, sister-in-law Marilyn Dykstra, brother-in-law Harold Kuiper, and many extended family members.
