



## Austin "Audi" Albrecht

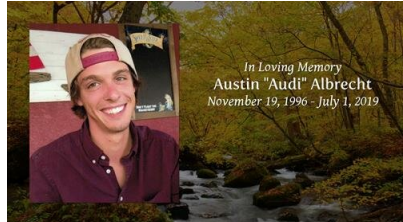
November 19, 1996 - July 1, 2019
