Betty Jane Dubois (nee DeKoning), age 95, is celebrating her meeting with her Savior after she passed from this world on Wednesday, December 26, 2018. She was a loving and caring wife, mother and grandmother whose main desire was to provide love, care and support for her family. During World War II, Betty was a "Rosie the Riveter" at Hayes Manufacturing Corporation in Grand Rapids, riveting windshields onto airplanes. Not long after the War, she married Tony Dubois and spent most of her younger years caring for their seven children and 2 nieces, raising them to be loving and caring adults. She and Tony lived in Grand Rapids until his work as a teacher prompted a move to Holland in 1959, where they settled into the community and church they loved so well. She loved working with children, and took great joy in spending time with and caring for her grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Betty was a member of Prospect Park Christian Reformed Church until its closure, joining Graafschap Christian Reformed Church thereafter.
