Betty was very proud of the role she played as a member of the founding Board of Trustees of Hospice of Holland and also served as a trained hospice volunteer. Betty was a devoted Christian whose faith inspired others, and was, most recently, a member at Second Reformed Church in Zeeland. Prior to that she was a member at Christ Memorial Church in Holland where she found a family in her church choir. Until her death, Betty

loved her time singing with her friends in the Freedom Village choir. Betty also served as the finance committee chair for the Reformed Church in America (Great Lakes Region).
