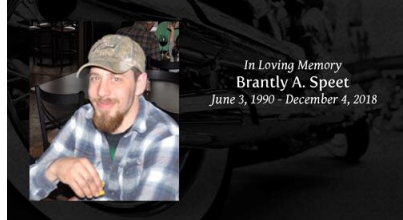
He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Amy Covell and Max Argo.
