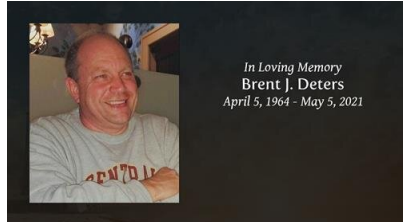
Rev. Josh Harrington will officiate a private family service. A public burial and graveside service (masks required) is planned for 2:00pm Tuesday, May 11 at
