November 20, 1929 - October 16, 2018

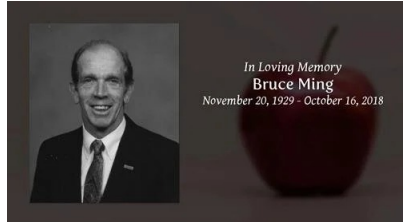
Bruce Jarvis Ming, 88, of Holland, died peacefully in his earthly home and was welcomed into his eternal home on Tuesday, October 16, 2018. He was honored to be a Senior Olympian and carried the torch when the games were held in Holland.
