When my father past away, I FaceTimed Bryan in tears. He sat there listening to me. He saw me punch a wall, he so wanted to be there for me & give me a hug.

We both wrote the words of what I should say at dad's funeral.

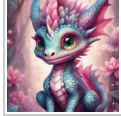
We always ended our conversation with

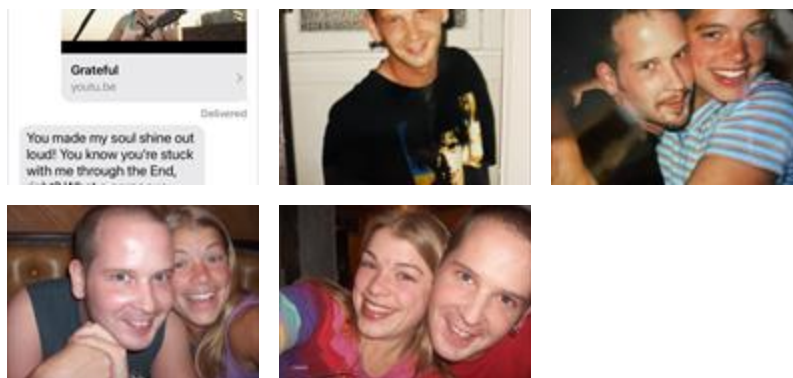
