October 15, 1938 - February 2, 2019

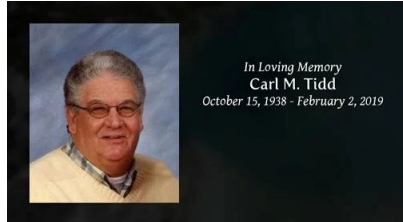
Carl M. Tidd age 80, of Hamilton, went to be with His Lord on Saturday, February 2, 2019 at Spectrum Health Butterworth Campus. Carl was born on October 15, 1938 to Carl and Marietta (Rigterink) Tidd in Holland, MI. He graduated from Holland High School, attended Michigan State University, graduated from Hope College, and received his master's degree from Western Michigan University. He taught at Hamilton High School and was a guidance counselor at Grandville High School. Carl was a member of Haven Reformed Church where he served as elder, deacon, and Sunday School teacher. He was the last Justice of the Peace in Overisel Township, served as Supervisor of Heath Township, and was on the Board of Review in Manlius Township.
