



## Charles "Chuck" VanDerKolk

December 20, 1953 - January 19, 2018

Charles (Chuck) VanDerKolk, age 64, passed away on January 19, 2018. Chuck prioritized his time around loving people. He was a true servant and this was exemplified in many ways. He cultivated the hearts of young people by sharing the love of Christ while serving as a volunteer youth leader for more than 30 years, leading countless mission trips to Mexico and Young Life's Lake Champion and Frontier Ranch camps. His servant leadership was portrayed in his professional life where he served as the Water Operations Manager in the Zeeland Board of Public Works for 44 years and on several water committees, including the director and VP of the American Water Works Association (AWWA) and the ABC board of directors.
