



Chester H. Johnson

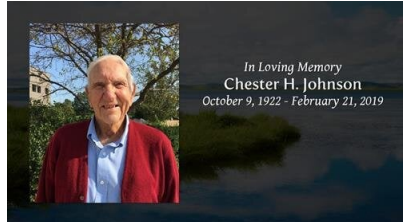
October 9, 1922 - February 21, 2019
