“ *What I remember most about Curt are his big smile and big heart, and of course his corny jokes. For 3 or 4 years right before dementia set in, we spent every Wednesday evening together at Providence Church serving food at Community Grill. I was usually in the kitchen and Curt manned the commercial-sized grill outside, usually with at least one of his daughters. I would come outside to collect the hotdogs and hamburgers, and sweat would be dripping down his face from standing over a hot grill. But, he would always have a smile on his face and greet me with a joke or dry comment. And he wasn't just grilling meat. He was also building relationships with people in the community. Everyone that came to Community Grill knew Curt, and they would stop and talk to him at the grill on their way in or out.*

Curt and his family also came along side my family in a very meaningful way when we needed it most. I will always remember the kindness Curt and his family showed to mine.

Curt, you will be missed. But, I am so happy that you are now free from this terrible disease that stole so much of your amazing personality!
