Daniel Charles DeLeeuw, 63, died on Tuesday, June 5, 2018, surrounded by his loving family. He was born on January 8, 1955, in Holland, Michigan, the seventh of thirteen children, to Warner and Frayna DeLeeuw Jr, who preceded him in death. Also preceding him in death, his sister Carolyn Essenburgh and his brother, Steve DeLeeuw.

Dan graduated from Holland Christian High School and attended Grand Valley State University. He was a partner in DeLeeuw Lumber Company, where he worked his entire career; often speaking in his sleep of 2x4s and other rough cuts. He was the best kind of company – keenly attuned to the importance and value of each person, natural with a joke, and generous with his love for his family and the Lord. He will be greatly missed.
