Born in Milwaukee, WI., he is the son of the late Raymond and the late Dorothy Hahn. Following his graduation from Pulaski High School (Milwaukee, WI), Daniel enlisted in the Army and was stationed in Alaska. He used his GI Bill to fund his associate's degree in Lay Ministry from Concordia College. He also earned his associate's degree from Milwaukee Area Technical College, which formed the foundation for his long-standing career in the restaurant and hospitality industry. After working in a variety of settings, Daniel ended his career as a café manager at a Borders Bookstore.

Daniel's faith was a very important part of his life. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran Church - Missouri Synod. His Lay Ministry degree helped to prepare him for his Christian service both within the church and in the community. Upon moving to Holland, he began volunteering at Legacy Thrift - South Holland. He spent many years as a cashier, greeting all with a genuine smile, frequent kind gestures and an occasional corny joke.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his father-in-law, Theodore Rozendal.
