



Dick B. Yskes

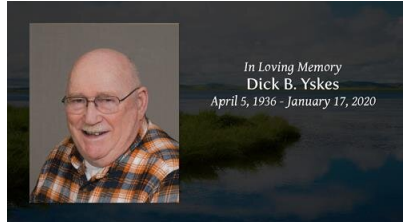
April 5, 1936 - January 17, 2020
