Doris Pyle Vandenberg was gathered to the church triumphant Saturday, January 02, 2016. Doris was born February 25, 1930, the youngest daughter of Fred and Jennie Ensink at their farm near Hudsonville. After graduation from Hudsonville High School in 1948, she was a student at Calvin College for five semesters and then taught in Hudsonville. In 1951 she married Henry Pyle and settled on the family farm. They had three daughters, Mary, Linda, and Julie. Doris lived her faith in a manner that was a sacrifice of thanksgiving to her Lord. She volunteered her gifts generously in the ministry of First Reformed Church of Zeeland and was part of the Gideon Auxiliary. Her special gifts included an attractive personality and rich musical talent. Many recall her for her ministries as a piano teacher and vocal soloist. Her husband, Henry, died in 2007 after 55 years of marriage. In 2013, she was united in marriage with Donald A. Vandenberg.
