



Dorothy J. Zoerman

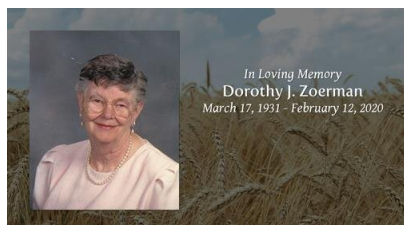
March 17, 1931 - February 12, 2020
