



Rev. Dr. Roger E. Kleinheksel

July 24, 1938 - January 7, 2022

Rev. Dr. Roger Edwin Kleinheksel, age 83, of Holland, was called home into the arms of Jesus the morning of January 7, 2022. Roger passed away peacefully at home as a result of complications from Pulmonary Fibrosis. Roger was a member of First Reformed Church of Zeeland where he also served as an administrative pastor for 17 years. He loved Jesus Christ and served Him in all areas of his life. His ministry included serving as pastor to Huron Valley Reformed Church in Rockwood, MI, (founding pastor), Hope Community Church in Sacramento, CA, Fellowship Reformed Church in Hudsonville, MI, Manorville Community Church in Manorville, Long Island, NY, (founding pastor), and he served on the board of Bradenton Chapel, FL for 40 years. He was born on July 24, 1938, in Hamilton, MI. He will be lovingly remembered by his wife of 60 years, Virginia (Top) Kleinheksel; his children, Rev.
