Elinor Carolyn Gran Heusinkveld Faber, 94, of Holland, passed away on Thursday, November 17, 2016 and is now with her Lord and Savior. Elinor was born in St. Paul, Minnesota on November 2, 1922, to Christian and Hilda Gran. After graduation from the University of Minnesota as a Registered Nurse in 1943, she married Dr. Maurice Heusinkveld MD. The couple were missionaries, serving in the Reformed Church of America's Arabian Mission from 1946 to 1967, with assignments in Kuwait, Iraq, Bahrain and Oman. After Maurice died in 1967, Elinor returned to America and settled in Holland, Michigan. In 1972, Elinor married Mr. Clarence Faber, who owned and managed the Parkview Adult Foster Care Home in Zeeland, Michigan. After Clarence passed away in 1984, Elinor moved back to Holland. She was a member of Bethany Christian Reformed Church. Elinor was preceded in death by husband Maurice Heusinkveld, husband Clarence Faber, son Terry Heusinkveld, and stepson Thomas Faber. Elinor is survived by son David Heusinkveld of Grayslake, Illinois; son Paul Heusinkveld of Holland, Michigan; stepdaughter Janice Jonker of Holland, Michigan, stepdaughter Trudy Bolthouse of Muskegon, Michigan; and stepson Richard Faber of Borculo, Michigan. She is also survived by 15 grandchildren and 18 great-grandchildren. Burial was in Pine Hill Cemetery, Grand Rapids, Michigan on 21 November. A memorial service is being planned for mid-January.
