



Frederick "Fred" Zeeff

May 16, 1928 - July 20, 2018

Frederick (Fred) Zeeff age 90, of Zeeland, passed away at his home on Friday, July 20, 2018, following a struggle with lung and heart disease. Fred served in the 1st Infantry Division "The Big Red One" during WWII and was a part of the occupation forces at the end of the war. He worked for the Ottawa County Sherriff's Department from 1960-1990. He also worked for 40 years with his best friend, Arlan Hossink, at Windmill Mobile Homes.
