



Gary Hulst

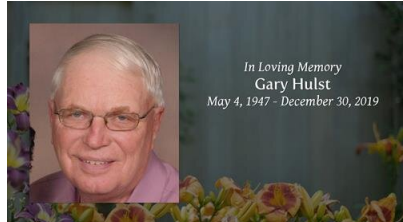
May 4, 1947 - December 30, 2019
