Harold "Herk" Wolters age 84, of Holland, passed peacefully into eternal glory on Tuesday, February 18, 2025, surrounded by his loving family.

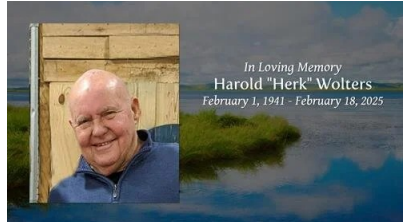
