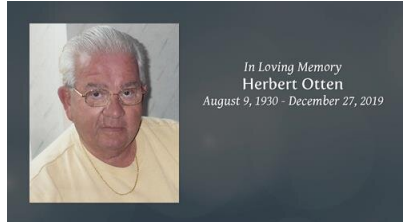
August 9, 1930 - December 27, 2019
