John U. Tuttle, 87, of Haslett, MI, passed away Saturday, May 16, 2015, at Beacon Hill at Eastgate. John was born in Concord, Merrimack County, N.H. January 3, 1928, to Philip and Edith (Unwin) Tuttle. He graduated from Concord High School in June of 1946. He graduated from Michigan State University in March, 1952 with a degree in journalism. John married Margaret (Peggy) Bos on October 25, 1952, in Zeeland, Ottawa County, MI. John worked at newspapers in Clyde, OH, Stanton, MI, Stoughton, WI, St. Joseph, MI, Grand Rapids, MI, Decatur, IL, and Lansing, MI. John's talents led him to be the national news editor of the Lansing State Journal. John retired from the Lansing State Journal in 1994. Sadly, in 1980, Peggy preceded John in death. He was also preceded in death by his brother Kenneth Tuttle. John was a man of character who worked hard and treasured his family. John's work life in journalism was important, but so was being a good husband to Peggy, and a good father to Robin and Doug. John enjoyed being his sons' little league coach and always pitched in with the boys many activities. He enjoyed nature and loved animals and wildlife. John was also an avid genealogist, tracing back several branches of his and Peggy's family tree. He is survived by his sons: J. Robin and Margaret Tuttle of Rockford, Douglas J. Tuttle of Haslett; brother Ronald and Mary Lou Tuttle of Winterhaven, FL, sister-in-law Ruth and Al Goorman of Zeeland, and nieces and nephews.
