John Van Dam, 81, passed away Monday, October 15, 2018. John was born in Zeeland on July 18, 1937, to John and Janet (Van Gelderen) Van Dam. He graduated from Zeeland High School in 1955. He went on to Hope College where he was an OKE "fratter" and graduated in 1959. John became a teacher for few years, until his father's untimely death, when John entered the family business, Modern Beverage Co. Modern Beverage was sold in 2015 after they celebrated their 75th anniversary in business. John was a past-president of the Michigan Beer & Wine Wholesalers Association.
