After several fun days, we were bussed back up top where we boarded the Copper Canyon train, which took us to the west coast where we caught a plane back to El Paso. Jim and I also spent a few days with Joyce and Jay at their B&B near Navajo Lake after the guys retired, but eventually we lost touch for the most part. Oh, my. What amazing memories.
