March 15, 1927 - March 13, 2019

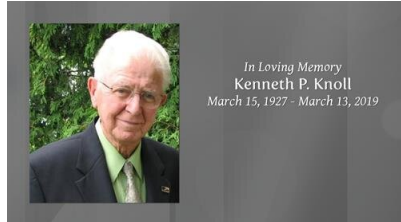
