Larry W Essenburg, 67, of Holland, passed away peacefully late Friday July 22, 2016 at home, after a year and a half long battle with cancer. Larry was born in Holland and graduated from West Ottawa High school. He served his country in Vietnam as a member of the US Army. He was a member of Christ Memorial Reformed Church where he enjoyed teaching Sunday school for many years. Larry and Connie started their own injection molding business, Ess Tec, Inc. in 1992.
