LeRoy Brookhouse age 90, of Holland, died Thursday, December 4, 2014 at his home. He was a member of Redeemer Presbyterian Church and retired from Haworth following 39 years of employment. LeRoy served his country during WWII as a member of the Army. His action included the invasion of Normandy on D-Day, the Battle of the Bulge, Ramagen Bridge construction (one of the first trucks to drive over upon completion), and the liberation of the Buchenwald concentration camp. He was an avid outdoorsman who loved hunting and fishing. He was also a master woodworker who enjoyed giving his crafts to others. LeRoy is survived by his wife of 64 years, Geneva; sons, Steve and Karen Brookhouse of Holland, Kirk and Kathryn Brookhouse of Holland; 4 grandchildren, Anna and Bill Palmer of Kentwood, Abby and Dan Medawar of Belmont, Doug and Jenny Brookhouse of Grand Haven, Jenny and Brian Stilley of Holland; 6 great grandchildren, Lilly Mae Medawar, Adelynn Medawar, Kaine Brookhouse, Macy Brookhouse, Owen Palmer, Quinn Palmer; sister, Doris Weller of Holland; brother-in-law, John Masselink of Zeeland.
