Louise was known for her passion of art and her love of sharing her work with others. Louise loved the country life, painting flowers, gardening, and making new friends. She leaves behind her husband Richard, daughters Adrienne & Amy, and countless friends who have been blessed by her art and social nature.

Cancer made the last months of her life difficult, and it brings us joy to know she is young again and enjoying life the way she was created to.
