Lydia Longoria, age 91, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, January 6, 2026, surrounded by the love and presence of her family.

Born in Coamo, Puerto Rico and raised in Cayey, Lydia left the island at the age of 19 and began a new chapter in Michigan. Through perseverance, humility, and quiet strength, she built a life centered on faith, family, and hard work. She made Holland, Michigan her home, where she worked in manufacturing and the agriculture industry while lovingly raising her family with dedication and resolve.

Lydia was a lifelong and faithful member of the Missionary Church of Christ. Her faith was not only professed but lived daily. 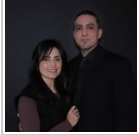
