July 3, 1949 - June 14, 2019

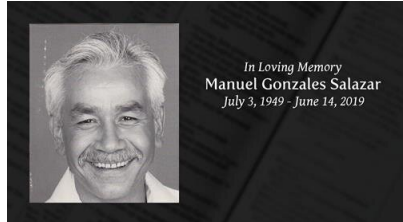
