March 28, 1932 - January 2, 2020

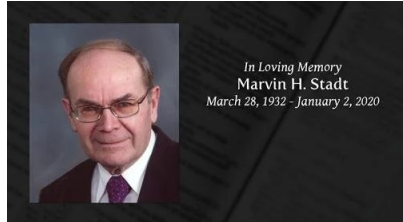
