Mary Ann Van't Hof, 75, of Holland, passed away Wednesday, November 27, 2013, after a long battle with Parkinson's and Alzheimer's Disease.

Mary Ann was born April 26, 1938, in Sheboygan, Wisconsin, and moved to Holland at six years of age. She started playing the organ at the age of 11 in her parent's restaurant (Cumerfords). She graduated from Holland High in 1956. Mary Ann attended Hope College where she met and married Don Van't Hof. She taught organ and piano for over 20 years. She retired from Ottawa Savings Bank after 20 years.

Mary Ann is a member of Second Reformed Church of Zeeland where she taught Sunday School, attended Bible Study, and was in the church knitting groups. She loves her family and enjoys camping and taking trips in the motor home. She enjoys having coffee sitting on the deck of her home overlooking Lake Mac.
