Pastor Philip James Schout, age 77 of Hudsonville, went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, January 23, 2024.

He is survived by his wife of 33 years, Shelby Schout; siblings: John (Judy) Schout, Sharon (Lon) Rupp, Beverly (Harvin) Geerts; sisters-in-law, Arloa Schout, Marilyn Overbey; and many nieces, nephews, great nieces, and great nephews.
