



Pat Lampen

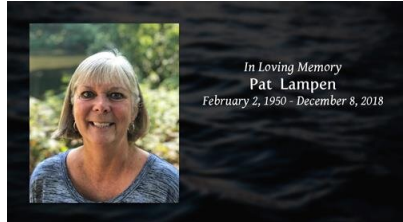
February 2, 1950 - December 8, 2018
