Paul was a graduate of Mt. Carmel High School in Chicago, Northwestern University in Evanston and Northwestern Law School. He was a former General Counsel at Pettibone Corporation in Chicago. He was admitted to both the Illinois Supreme Court and the U.S. Supreme Court. He was a former antitrust attorney for the United States Department of Justice in Chicago and later in private practice at Liebman Williams (Sidley and Austin) in Chicago.
