Pauline (Polly) Schrottenboer, age 96, went to be with her Lord and Savior on Sunday, February 24, 2019. Polly was born January 27, 1923 on a farm in Hillsdale County, Michigan to Ralph and Alice (Wilcox) Taylor, one of eleven children. She was a member of Graafschap Christian Reformed Church. She was a member of the Ladies' Aid Society at Graafschap CRC, as well as a former Sunday School teacher and Calvinette (GEMS) Counselor.
