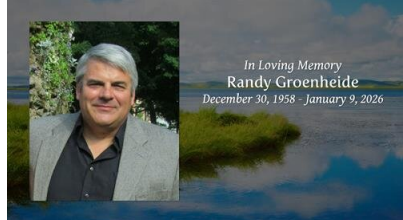

But...we had so much fun, because any time you were with Randy, it was fun. As was said at the funeral, he could tease you and you didn't even mind. My heart is aching for Connie and his family - I cannot imagine the huge hole this has left in their family's lives. Say "hi" to our son Ben in heaven and we'll see you soon.
