



Rhona June Hulst

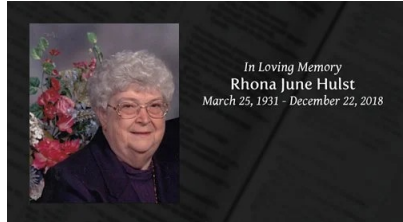
March 25, 1931 - December 22, 2018
