Rev. Robert Jordan Hanna, 91, of Holland, made his last move, and went to be with the Lord September 13, 2015. Robert was born January 1, 1924, in New Castle, Pennsylvania, to Robert and Ethel (Kurtz) Hanna. He graduated from high school and served his country in the U.S. Army as a Staff Sergeant and cook during World War II while stationed on Guadalcanal and the Philippines from 1942-1945. After WWII, Robert dedicated his life to serving Christ as an ordained minister at churches in Glasgow, MT, Superior, WI, Harrisville, IN, Chicago, IL, Saugatuck, Muskegon, and Allegan. Robert also worked for the Ottawa County Dept. of Social Services prior to his retirement. He is a member of Hope Church. In 2002, he was preceded in death by his wife of 51 years, Margaret. He was also preceded in death by his parents, sister Freda Hanna, brothers: William Hanna, Charles Hanna; parents-in-law: William and Agnes Graham, brother-in-law William Graham.
