



Robert D. Rosendahl

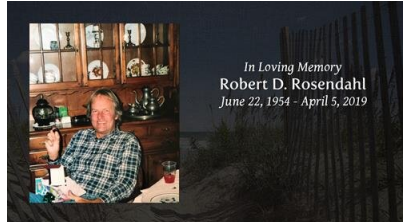
April 5, 1955 - April 5, 2019
