



Rodger L. Dangremond

March 18, 1932 - March 17, 2019

Rodger Dangremond age 86, of Holland, died Sunday, March 17, 2019 surrounded by his family. It was one day prior to his 87th birthday. He was a member of Christ Memorial Church and was a veteran of the Korean War, serving in the Air Force. He served from 1952-1956 with two years in Japan as a Cryptographer. During retirement, Rodger traced his ancestry back to 1315 and the French Huguenots. He retired from Micromatic Textron in Engineering Management. Rodger and Judy spent 25 years wintering in Florida.
