



Ruth Kaashoek

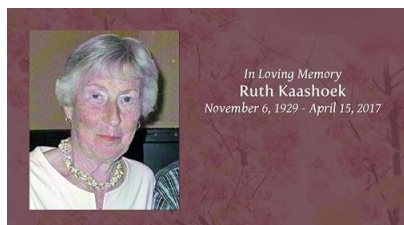
November 6, 1929 - April 15, 2017
