Ruth Tyink, age 76, of Holland, passed away on Tuesday, January 21, 2025.

Ruth was born in Zeeland, Michigan, on January 31, 1948, to Gerrit and Fenna (Geerts) Loedeman. After years in Zeeland Schools she transferred to Hamilton High School (class of 1967). While there she met the love of her life, Philip Tyink.

Ruth and Philip were married in July of 1967 and later welcomed their son Douglas Tyink. While Philip was in the U.S. Navy for 10 years, Ruth and Douglas moved with him whenever possible. Together they lived in: Key West, Florida, Barbers Point, Hawaii, and Adak, Alaska. Following Philip's service time, the family returned to their roots in West Michigan.

After their return, Ruth worked primarily as a waitress/hostess. She spent time at the Cumerford Restaurant, around 10 years at Russ' where she served all three West Michigan locations, and 22 years at the Holland Country Club. Ruth and Philip later moved to North Carolina where she worked 10 years at the Rock Barn Country Club and Spa in Conover, NC.

Ruth and Philip returned to West Michigan after retirement. In addition to her work, she enjoyed cooking and baking as well as time with her husband and family. Ruth was dearly loved and will be deeply missed.

She is survived by her husband of 57 years, Philip Tyink; son, Douglas Tyink; grandchildren, Zachary Tyink, Jordan Tyink; great grandchildren: Sebastian Tyink and Xena Tyink; sister, Jean (Don) Lam; and sister-in-law, Deborah (Dale) Davis.
