



## Rev. Scott A. DeVries

June 9, 1976 - April 27, 2024

Rev. Scott DeVries, age 47, of Holland, passed away Saturday, April 27, 2024, five weeks after being diagnosed with stage 4 cancer.

Scott was a 1994 graduate of South Christian High School, earned an engineering degree from Michigan State University and his Master of Divinity degree from Calvin Theological Seminary. He pastored at West Olive Christian Reformed Church and Bethany Christian Reformed Church. He also served the Christian Reformed Church Classis Holland and was currently the Director of Synodical Services for the Christian Reformed Church in North America.

Scott was an adventurer who loved enjoying the beauty of God's creation through backpacking, fishing, camping, hiking, and skiing. He was an avid reader, a loyal friend, dedicated husband, and loyal father.
