Stanley J. Koster, 84, of Holland, passed away Friday, February 22, 2019 at the Inn at Freedom Village. Born in McBain, MI, Stan taught at Northern Michigan Christian School, Grand Rapids Christian School and Trinity Christian College. He also served as the Superintendent of Holland Christian Schools from 1978 until his retirement in 1997. After retirement, Stan took on the role of Coaching Coordinator for the Christian Reformed Church, serving as a guide to many pastors, church councils and congregations. Throughout his life, Stan was a treasured mentor to many. Stan was a member of Bethany Christian Reformed Church and served in the US Army during the Korean War.
